

Recommendation: County of Fresno 2022 Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG)

The County of Fresno receives HUD ESG annually to engage homeless individuals and families living on the street, improve the number and quality of emergency shelters for homeless individuals and families, help operate these shelters, provide essential services to shelter residents, rapidly rehouse homeless individuals and families, and prevent families and individuals from becoming homeless.

The County of Fresno is recommending utilizing the 2022 funds for rapid rehousing and administrative purposes, to assist in transitioning individuals and families from our emergency shelters into permanent housing. Although the 2022 allocations have not been released the numbers below are estimates based on the 2021 award amount. The percentages will be used to adjust the actuals once the allocations are released.
