

## City of Fresno FMCoC agenda updates

- **ERF-1 Encampment Status Update as of January 31, 2023**
  - 38 individuals permanently housed.
  - 516 unique individuals contacted within the encampment area.
  - 162 individuals continue to reside in the encampment area.
  - 69 individuals residing within the Village of Hope emergency shelter.
- **COF is currently working on completing the ERF-2 application which is due February 28<sup>th</sup>.**
  - For ERF-2 requesting to increase the amount of outreach workers and adding a mental health clinician.
  - Incorporating bridge housing into the grant.
  - ERF-2 geographic location is the same as ERF-1.
- **Local Housing Trust Fund (LHTF) NOFA will be released by the end of February or early March.**
- **Permanent Local Housing Allocation (PLHA)- City received Executed Amended Agreements Number 20-PLHA-15156, AM. 1**
  - Approving the Amended AMI limits from 60% AMI to 80% for Multi-Family and Single-Family affordable rental housing projects.
  - PLHA1- \$3,407,603
  - PLHA2-\$5,296,740
  - PLHA 3-City of Fresno received award notification of the 2022 PLHA, Formula Allocation Round 3 \$5,828,601 (Standard agreement fourth coming)
- **HHAP 4**
  - On 2/17/2023, COF submitted the following.
    - Baseline Questions
    - Updated Funding Analysis
- **2023-24 Annual Action Plan (AAP) Process Update**
  - NOFA applications reviewed/scored.
  - Recommended funding will be included in draft AAP to be published March 6.
- **COF will have a public comment opportunity for Substantial Amendment 2020-04 through March 20<sup>th</sup>. The substantial amendment allows the City to develop affordable housing at the sites it purchase to also develop a senior center.**
- **Mobile Medical Clinic RFP (CDBG-CV)**
  - RFP Closed
  - Staff to review/score applications received.
- **Tenant/Landlord Counseling RFP (CDBG-CV)**
  - RFP closed.
  - Staff to review/score applications received.
- **Big City Mayor report. First week of March going to start work on gathering data for the BCM.**
- **COF attended a meeting with the City of Tulare to review their Safe Camp.**
- **Shelter Plan:**
  - **Step Up going offline in June. City is currently working on managing the transition.**
    - Villa (50 rooms) going online in March.
    - Parkway (62 rooms) going online at the end of May.
    - Bridge housing and shelter in D4- (115 rooms)
    - Family Shelter D-6 (56 rooms)
    - D-5 shelter (25 rooms)
