

FMCoC City of Fresno Updates January Meeting

- Local Housing Trust Fund
 - The results from the community engagement were gathered.
 - Location (*Promote new affordable housing in areas of high-opportunity in our downtown neighborhoods*): 115
 - Community Need (*Promote projects that include a documented community need such as publicly accessible plazas or parks*): 146
 - Universal Design (*Promote projects that include accessibility into their design so that people of ages and abilities can live there*): 101
 - Climate Change (*Promote buildings that are designed to reduce the impacts of climate change.*) :107
 - Adaptive Reuse: (*Promote the reuse of old buildings into new residence*) :129
 - BIPOC/Women-led: (*Promote projects that are led by or committed to hiring local Black, Indigenous, People of Color, and women-owned business*) 86
 - Nonprofit-Led: (*Promote projects that are led by a non-profit entity whose mission is related to affordable housing, community empowerment and/or neighborhood development*) 53
 - Currently working on building the RFP around the results that were gathered.
- Mobile Showers
 - Three new locations are being considered in the downtown area and Tower District.
 - New locations potentially will be started in January.
- HART Team
 - Taking part in the Point-in-Time Count.
- Encampment Resolution Funding (ERF 2)
 - City is considering applying for round two of funding.
